8: Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

9: Six days shalt thou labor and do all thy work:

10: But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates;

11: For in six days the LORD made the heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day; wherefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

The Gospel Commission: Matthew 28:18-20 (KJV)

18: And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

19: Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost:

20: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen

What Seventh-day Adventists Believe

That the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testament were inspired of God and are the only unerring rule of faith and practice for the Christian. (2 Timothy 3:15-17) That the Godhead or Trinity consists of the Father, His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19, Luke 3:21, 22)

- That Jesus Died for our sins on the cross, was raised from the dead, and ascended to the Father to intercede for us. (Hebrews 2:9-18, 8:1)
- That salvation is received by grace through faith, not from our works. Obedience to God's law is a response of love and gratitude. (Ephesians 2:8, 9, John 14:15)
- That our Savior is coming again soon in literal, visible glory, as a grand climax to the plan of salvation. (John 14:1-3, Acts 1:9-11, Revelation 7, Hebrews 9:28)
- That baptism by immersion is the Savior's plan and should follow repentance and forgiveness of sins. (Romans 6:1-6, Acts 16:30-33)
- That the will of God, as it relates to moral conduct, is comprehended in His law of ten commandments, which are great, moral, unchangeable precepts, binding upon all men every age. (Exodus 20:1-17, Romans 6:14-16)
- That the seventh-day Sabbath is a memorial of creation, a sign of sanctification, a day of healing and service to others, and a present reminder of our rest through faith in Christ. (Genesis 2:1-3, Exodus 20:8-11, Deuteronomy 5:12-15, Isaiah 58, Hebrews 4:1-10)
- That the divine principle of returning tithes to God for support of the Gospel is an acknowledgement of God's ownership in our lives. (Leviticus 27:30, Malachi 3:8-12, I Corinthians 9:9-14)
