What Seventh-day Adventists Believe

That the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testament were inspired of God and are the only unerring rule of faith and practice for the Christian. (2 Timothy 3:15-17)That the Godhead or Trinity consists of the Father, His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19, Luke 3:21, 22)

- That the will of God, as it relates to moral conduct, is comprehended in His law of ten commandments, which are great, moral, unchangeable precepts, binding upon all men every age. (Exodus 20:1-17, Romans 6:14-16)
- That the seventh-day Sabbath is a memorial of creation, a sign of sanctification, a day of healing and service to others, and a present reminder of our rest through faith in Christ. (Genesis 2:1-3, Exodus 20:8-11, Deuteronomy 5:12-15, Isaiah 58, Hebrews 4:1-10)
- That the divine principle of returning tithes to God for support of the Gospel is an acknowledgement of God's ownership in our lives. (Leviticus 27:30, Malachi 3:8-12, I Corinthians 9:9-14)
