What Seventh-day Adventists Believe

That the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testament were inspired of God and are the only unerring rule of faith and practice for the Christian (2 Timothy 3:15-17)That the Godhead or Trinity consists of the Father, His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.
